#### **ANNUAL REPORT 2021-2022**

#### **HIGHLIGHTS**

For the year under report 3039 books were added to the collection and 359 periodicals subscribed from University Funds. Databases consisting of e-journals, e-books, statistical data, time series data etc. continued to support teaching and research. 2139 members registered in KRC with 14102 visitors visiting daily and using 15151 documents. 41881 was the use of databases.

Due to the coronavirus wave, BMK-KRC was kept open for all the days and operated by 50% of staff at the beginning of the year. However, later as the severity of the virus increased the BMK-KRC was kept open thrice a week till June 2021. As part of 'work from home' the data of the accession register was edited by all the staff.

BMK-KRC had supported users in terms of education and research in blended ways, physical and online mode. The online resources were promoted for use by conducting 'database awareness program' which were held online. BMK-KRC conducted an online demonstration programme of ProQuest Central, eBooks, Knimbus and Orientation lectures to the students. Workshop on SNDT Women's University E-resources was also organized by BMK Knowledge Resource Centre. This year 15 programmes were conducted and 1260 participants were trained in the usage of various information resources.

KRC celebrated "ग्रंथोत्सव" and "वाचन प्रेरणा दिन", the birth anniversary of Dr. Abdul Kalam which has been declared as by the United Nations during 12 to 14 October 2021. A motivational lecture on "तरुण पिढीसाठी ग्रंथ वाचनाचे महत्व", delivered by Shri Narendra Wabale (Chairman, Mumbai Marathi Patrakar Sangh, Patrakar Bhavan, Mumbai) and "स्पर्धा परीक्षेसाठी वाचनाचा राजमार्ग" delivered by Shri Atul Kulkarni (IPS, Chandrapur) were organized on the occasion of Reading Inspiration Day.

On June 16, 2021 the renovated KRC Juhu Branch library was inaugurated by Higher Education Minister Shri Udayji Samant and SNDT WU VC Prof. Shashikala Wanjari. The renovated KRC was refurbished with a partition between reading room and stack area, circulation counter was made, window grills and LED display board (Electronic board) were installed. Laying of cables for internet, cctv cameras, electric work, AC in lab, furniture etc was completed. After deep

dusting, cleaning, shifting and arranging books by group shelving, KRC was operational from 10.1.2022. Lounge area was developed with new arrival books, reading corner, area for pick up book, tea/coffee vending machine, display of newspaper, book display on different subjects, general reading magazines, display of library information, display of best user and display of thought for today.

Pre and post user survey of students was done for databases to know their expectations, research areas and post session feedback.

From plagiarism software Ouriginal (formerly Urkund) only PhD thesis and faculty research articles were checked as per new norms.

KRC continued to provide an opportunity to pass out MLISc students to take up an internship for 100 hours. During internship the students gain practical knowledge on handling various library operations.

Books from the Distance Education department library were shifted to Juhu KRC which now occupies a reading corner for students to read and relax.

The Expert Team visited the library as part of Department Evaluation of Dept of Special Education visited on 8.9.2021 and later again.
