



Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) Between SNDT Women's University, Mumbai & Dr. Anjali Morris Education and Health Foundation (AMF), Pune

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) Between SNDT College of Education, Pune, conducted college of SNDT Women's University, Mumbai and Dr. Anjali Morris Education and Health Foundation, Pune

SNDT (Shreemati Nathibai Damodar Thackersey) Women's University was established in 1916. The university is a public institution recognized by Government of Maharashtra having all India jurisdiction. The university engages in teaching, research and extension activities in KG to Ph.D. education through its university departments, conducted colleges/institutions and affiliated colleges. In 2024 there are three main campuses- two at Mumbai (Churchgate and Juhu) and one at Pune besides three campuses at Palghar, Shriwardhan and Chandrapur. The headquarters of university are at 1, Nathibai Thackersey Road, New Marine Lines, Mumbai- 400 020. S.N.D.T College Of Education, Pune was established in 1950 as a grant-in-aid constituent/conducted unit of the S.N.D.T. Women's University, Mumbai.

Dr. Anjali Morris Education and Health Foundation (AMF) is a registered not-for-profit company under Section 8 of the Indian Companies Act (2013) and has tax exempt status in India under section 80(G) of the Income Tax Act (1961). Since 2008, it is committed to helping students with Specific Learning Disabilities (SLDs) and Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD). It offers assessment and intervention to students with Specific Learning Disabilities (SLDs) and Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD), and trains teachers to work with these students in English and Marathi.

The term of this MOU is for next three academic years: 2025-26, 2026-27, 2027-28.

• Dr Anjali Morris Education and Health Foundation's Responsibilities:

1. Provide Learning Disability (LD) assessment tools for the B.Ed. (LD) program until the college acquires them, by May 2026.
2. Offer training for administering and analysing LD assessments conducted at AMF.
3. Conduct training on how to implement LD intervention programs.
4. Assist in procuring LD-related books, online resources, and learning materials.
5. Aid in organizing certificate courses, workshops, and week-long training programs for in-service teachers and parents.
6. Co-conduct the PG Diploma in Specific Learning Disability.
7. Provide guidance and support in setting up an LD Intervention Centre at SNDT College of Education, Pune.

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SNDT College of Education in collaboration with Dr Anjali Morris Education and Health Foundation will be offering PG Diploma in Specific Learning Disability. It will be a one-year diploma program.

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A) Dr Anjali Morris Education and Health Foundation's (AMF) Role in the Diploma Program:

AMF will-

1. Provide the syllabus for the diploma program, which will get approved from BOS and AC of the SNDT Women's University along with Fees fixation committee
2. Conduct the student selection process as per Dr Anjali Morris Education and Health Foundation's criteria. Dr Anjali Morris Education and Health Foundation will keep 20% seats reserved for SNDT students. However the students will have to go through the Dr Anjali Morris Education and Health Foundation selection process.
3. Offer fellowships to enrolled students according to their norms.
4. Take full responsibility for teaching and providing resource persons.
5. Pay minimum administrative fees to the University which includes exam fees, certificate, enrolment fees, any administrative charges, etc. as per the pre-decided rate per student.
6. The college will receive Rs.1000 per student per year from Dr Anjali Morris Education and Health Foundation under this MOU.

B) SNDT Women's University's Role in the Diploma Program:

1. The program will be hosted at the SNDT College of Education, Pune.
2. The diploma will be titled *Post Graduate Diploma in Specific Learning Disability* (PGDSDL).
 - Mode: Offline, face-to-face.
 - Duration: One academic year (Two Semesters) (960 hours, 44 credits).
 - Intake: 30 students.
 - Eligibility: B.Ed. graduates, postgraduates from any discipline.
3. The programme will be approved by the University academic bodies.
4. SNDT Women's University will conduct the final exam according to their norms at the end of each semester. The University will issue the mark list and certificate to the enrolled students.

C) Understanding Between the Two Institutions Regarding the One-Year Diploma Program:

1. The PG Diploma in Specific Learning Disability will be a joint program.
2. The theory component will be taught at SNDT College of Education, Pune, while the practical component will take place at Dr Anjali Morris Education and Health Foundation, Ghole Road, Pune.
3. A batch of 30 female students will be admitted annually. 20% seats will be reserved for SNDT students provided they get through the Dr Anjali Morris Education and Health Foundation selection process.
4. The final exam will be conducted by SNDT Women's University, Mumbai at the end of the program.

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D) Expectations from Dr Anjali Morris Education and Health Foundation: SNDT Women's University will provide the mark sheet after each semester and diploma certificate upon successful completion of the program.

E) Conditions from SNDT College of Education, Pune:

1. SNDT College of Education, Pune will not pay salaries or remuneration to the faculty teaching in this diploma program.

(Students will pay a maximum of Rs 4000/- towards all administrative expenses-Refer to sub point 5 of Section A)

Both the parties agree to terminate this MOU with mutual consent or prior written notice. Both the parties agree to complete the academic cycle of the students enrolled for the PG Diploma in the interest of the students.

The Principal of the SNDT College of Education will be the person executing the MOU on behalf of the University.


