
Shivsrushti lets visitors explore the legacy of Maratha Empire at one's own pace.

Since the theme park welcomes a large number of visitors every day, guests are first organized into groups before entering. These groups are uniquely named after the majestic forts of Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj. The students and professors of SNDT College of Education were sorted in the group ‘Vijaydurga’.

The visit officially began as the students entered inside the majestic establishment.

Swarajya, Swadharma, Swabhasha was the initial attraction. The grand hall was adorned with replicas of famous portraits and paintings of Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj. A splendid 3D model of Project Shivrushuti was interposed in the centre of the grand hall. Subsequently, Sir Shri.Jagdish Kadam apprised the visitors about the motive behind Project Shivrushuti.

Following the revolving show was a tour of Shastra Daalan, a gallery showcasing replica swords, armour, and weapons wielded by the brave soldiers of Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj. Sinhasanadhisvar and Ranangan showcased glorious replicas of stone inscriptions engraved in Devanagari and Modi Lipi plus warfare artefacts.

A regal 3D Model of Rajdarbar, wherein the coronation ceremony of Maharaj was held was displayed along with various significant historical artefacts used during the coronation ceremony.


